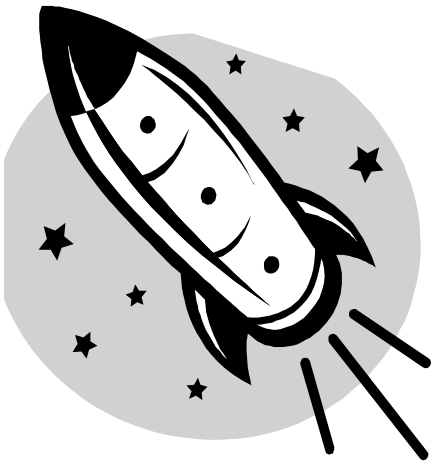


The **Third World Centre**
