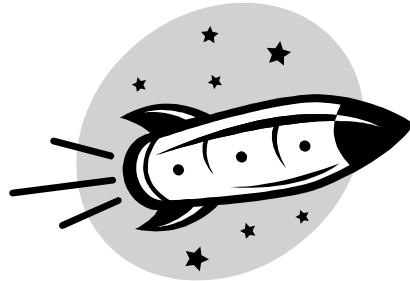
As you have noticed, the Church Hall has been redecorated over the summer. Now we need fresh photos for our activity's board.
